

**ROOSEVELT COUNTY ELECTRIC**

**OBJECTIVE**

The objective of the Roosevelt County Electric Education Foundation Scholarship Fund is to assist those individuals who desire to further their education and who desire to acquire the knowledge and skills to be better prepared to participate in the future employment marketplace.

One-year scholarships, in an amount to be determined on an annual basis by the Education Foundation, will be considered provided the following eligibility requirements have been met:

**ELIGIBILITY**

All criteria listed below must be met:

1. Available to dependents of members receiving service from Roosevelt County Electric Cooperative, Inc. or a legal dependent of a full-time employee of a member receiving service from the cooperative and said employee and dependent must be living in a residence connected in the member's name.
2. Applicants must be a graduating senior in the current year from an accredited public or private high school, home schooled or have obtained a New Mexico GED or equivalent.
3. Applicants should desire to enter a college, university or trade school.
4. Applications will be judged and awarded based on the following criteria:
  - a. ACT Scores
  - b. Secondary school GPA of 2.5 or higher
  - c. Community and other civic activities
  - d. Leadership and character qualities
  - e. Essay

**SELECTION PROCESS**

Selections will be determined by the Roosevelt County Electric Education Foundation selection committee.

**SCHOLARSHIP DISTRIBUTION**

Scholarships will be paid by check to the institution of student's choice in one installment upon proof of full time student registration for the fall semester of 2019.

**APPLICATION PROCESS**

Submit scholarship application to the Member Services Department, 121 North Main, Portales, New Mexico. The following documents must be received in the office by 5 P.M., Wednesday, January 9, 2019.

1. Completed and signed scholarship application.
2. High scholastic record with accumulative GPA and ACT scores.
3. At least two letters of recommendation from principal or teachers of the secondary school from which the applicant is graduating or an official, civic or religious leader of the community which the applicant resides.

One page or less typed or handwritten essay on how this scholarship will aid applicant in their educational goals.
