"Plug in to Win" Event Sponsored by WFEC



RCEC member Colleen Tollett pictured above with her husband Dennis, attended the "Plug in to Win" event sponsored by Western Farmers Electric Cooperative (WFEC) in Oklahoma City back in October. Colleen was the lucky winner of a \$100 Walmart gift card from WFEC at RCEC's 2019 annual meeting, which qualified her as a finalist for the Grand Prize Giveaway of \$5,000 at the Plug in to Win event.

Attendees were also the first to see a prototype of the first-ever electric Ford F-150 BEV, in addition to being present for the unveiling of a new comprehensive statewide EV charging station network in Oklahoma. Francis Renewable Energy is currently building the first comprehensive network of fast charging electric vehicle stations in the country to be complete in 2020.

As a result of this campaign, 15 cooperative members were in a drawing for \$5,000, culminating the year-long EV promotion. One finalist, Carma Morris of Shawnee, a member of Canadian Valley Electric Cooperative, took home the grand prize. Other finalists were also presented with various gift items. Through this enthusiasm, the success from the Plug in to Win campaign, as well as benefits from a statewide charging network, the future promises much more "down the road" for the EV market.

Whipped Sheet Cake Ice Cream

Ingredients

- 2 cups heavy whipping cream
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1 cup sweetened condensed milk
- 3/4 cup cocoa powder
- 3/4 cup chopped pecans or walnuts
- 2 tsp. vanilla extract

Instructions

1. In a large bowl, use a mixer on high speed to whip cream until stiff peaks form. Add sugar a small amount at a time to aid in the peak formation.
2. In a separate bowl, mix condensed milk, cocoa powder, chopped nuts and vanilla.
3. Fold the whipped cream into the condensed milk mixture and transfer to a freezer-safe covered container. Freeze until firm, at least 24 hours.

Non-Residential Deposits

Delinquent nonresidential accounts without a continuing letter of guaranty from financial institution are required to pay a deposit equal to 25% of the delinquent bill. On 3rd consecutive delinquency, a deposit equal to 1/6th of the estimated annual billing will be assessed.

Residential Deposits

For residential consumers a deposit equal to 1/6th of the estimated annual billing is required if the account becomes delinquent three or more times in one year. After that year, the deposit may be refunded and applied to the next month's bill provided the account has not been delinquent in that year. If a service is disconnected, the deposit is applied to the final bill if all requirements have been met.
