## Recipe Corner

## Pumpkin Goopy Butter Cake

Cake: 1 pkg. yellow cake mix  
 1 egg  
 8 tbsp. butter, melted

Filling: 1 15-ounce can of pumpkin  
 1 8 ounce pkg. softened cream cheese  
 8 tbsp. melted butter  
 1 16-ounce box powdered sugar

3 eggs  
 1 tsp vanilla  
 1 tsp cinnamon  
 1 tsp nutmeg

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. To make the cake, combine all of the ingredients and mix well. Pat the mixture into a lightly greased 13x9 baking pan.

To make the filling, in a large bowl, beat the cream cheese and pumpkin until smooth. Add the eggs, vanilla and butter and beat together. Next add the powdered sugar, cinnamon, nutmeg and mix well. Spread filling mixture over the pressed cake batter and bake 40 to 50 minutes. Make sure not to over bake as the center should be a little gooey.

## Non-Residential Deposits

Delinquent nonresidential accounts without a continuing letter of guaranty from financial institution are required to pay a deposit equal to 25% of the delinquent bill. On 3rd consecutive delinquency, a deposit equal to 1/6th of the estimated annual billing will be assessed.

Make sure to pick up your 2021 calendar featuring Pep, NM. when you pay your December bill. While supplies last!

## Holiday Safety Tip

**Smoke alarms** should be installed in every bedroom, outside each sleeping area, and on every level of the home. For best protection, smoke alarms should be interconnected so they all sound if one sounds. Test the batteries in each smoke alarm every month, replace once a year, and replace the unit every 10 years.

## Residential Deposits

For residential consumers a deposit equal to 1/6th of the estimated annual billing is required if the account becomes delinquent three or more times in one year. After that year, the deposit may be refunded and applied to the next month's bill provided the account has not been delinquent in that year. If a service is disconnected, the deposit is applied to the final bill if all requirements have been met.
